

A review of Safe Eyes

We now use Safe Eyes 2006 which has many of the standard features and comes highly recommended.







I Like it a lot. It looks very similar to other filtering software with the ability to set your safety as little or as much as you want. I like the log feature as well where I can go in and monitor the sites my teenage children visit by placing an alert status on those types of sites and not banning them entirely. I can then block individual sites as I need to. I am especially worried about them and the Xanga/Blogging websites so this helps me with that.

Safe Eyes is 49.95 per year, but it can be run on up to three computers. As you can tell, I am pretty pleased. It seems to run seamlessly in the background without slowing down the system too much like others I have tried.
